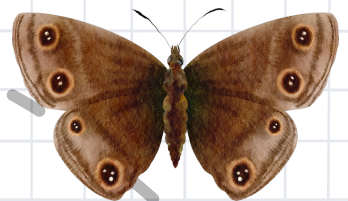
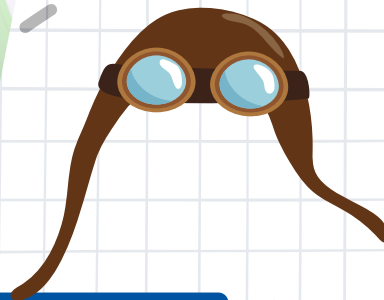
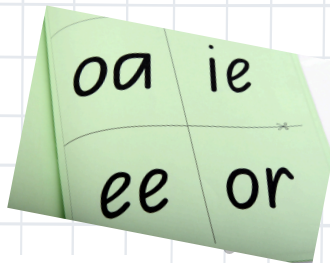
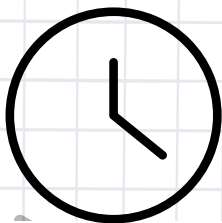


- Create a rhythm pattern
