## What did the Romans do for us?



As SCIENTISTS we will be: continuing to develop our skills and understanding of practical investigations whilst we learn about light and seeing. We will be learning how and why we need light to see, that darkness is the absence of light and how shadows are formed when light is blocked.

**In COMPUTING we will be:** continuing to use the internet safely and responsibly, whilst learning about branching databases and beginning to create our own.

As MUSICIANS we will: continue to learn to sing a range of different songs and play untuned percussion instruments.

In P.E. we will be: continuing to develop the skills we have been nurturing this year to access a range of team games, making up our own rules for a range of physical challenges.

In R.E. we will be: learning about sacred places in different faiths, and understanding what sacred means.

In ART we will be: developing our sculpting skills through using clay to create a Roman vase.

As HISTORIANS we will be: learning about the Roman invasion of Britain and how this changed culture and society. We will be exploring the development of settlements, roads, clothing, religion, and food since the Iron Age in Britain.

**In Jigsaw we will be:** learning about relationships, including family roles and responsibilities, maintaining friendships, keeping safe online and becoming a well-adjusted global citizen.
