



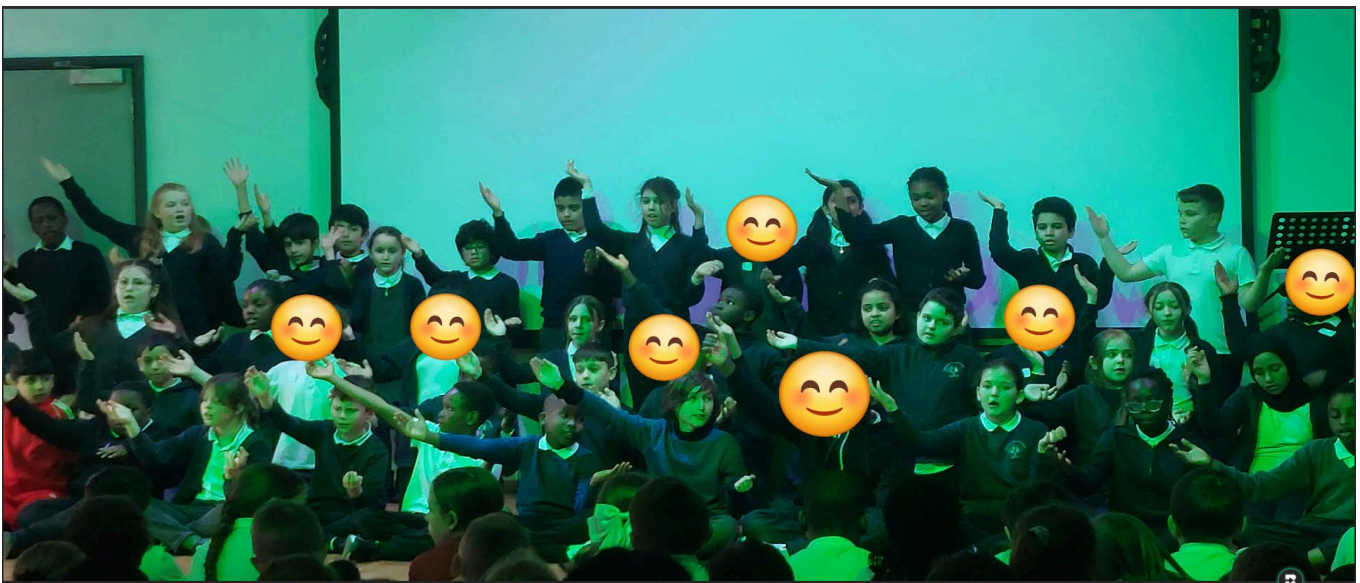
NEWSLETTER FOR SIDMOUTH PRIMARY SCHOOL

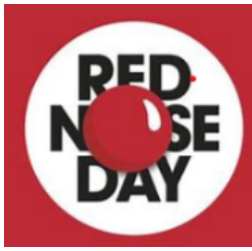
