



Free School Meals

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are aware that for many families, there have been some changes at home during the last 18 months of the pandemic and that this might have had an impact on your eligibility for free school meals. If you qualify for free school meals not only will your child receive free meals, but our school will receive additional funding too. **In addition to this, during the school holiday period, weekly vouchers (£15 per child) are allocated to spend at the supermarket to support food shopping over the summer break.**

If you need support with applying please contact the school office and we will be happy to help

You can apply for free school meals if your child attends a Hull school or sixth form on a full time basis by registering on My School Portal and completing the online form. In order to be eligible, you must be in receipt of one of the following benefit

- income support
- income based jobseekers allowance
- income related employment and support allowance (ESA – IR)
- universal credit if the household is earning less than £7,400 per year
- asylum seekers (receiving support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999)
- the guaranteed element of state pension credit
- child tax credit (with an annual income of no more than £16,190 as assessed by the Inland Revenue)
- working tax credit run on - paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for working tax credit

It is essential everyone who is eligible for a free school meal is registered, regardless if they have a school meal or a home packed lunch, as this will affect the funding the school receives. The more funding the school receives, the more opportunities for our pupils. Please ensure you complete an application, even if you believe your child is not eligible.
