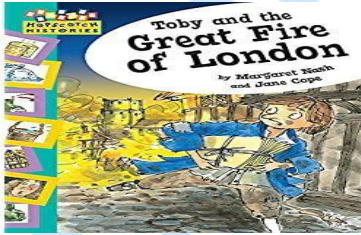


Year 2 Autumn Term 2 Curriculum Newsletter

Why was there a Great Fire of London?



In R.E. we will be: Exploring some of the beliefs and rituals of the Jewish, Christian and Islamic religions.

As MUSICIANS we will be: Learning to perform, listen to, review and evaluate different music.

As WRITERS we will be: Children will be exposed to 3 pieces of text this term; a list poem, a story to help develop our story writing skills, as well as writing recipes before Christmas. We will continue to focus on our handwriting and developing cursive writing. Children will be encouraged to use their 'Learning Muscles' to improve their work.

In P.E. we will be: Exploring P.E both indoor and outdoor. Children will be learning a variety of skills using different techniques. Children will be working with Mr Holmes during P.E this term

As READERS we will be: Clarifying, making predictions, and summarising books. We will also be asking and answering questions about our class text and information texts linked to our topic. We will continue to read our books at home and school, these books will be closely linked to our phonics level. We will continue to bring home school books to share with an adult who can read it with us.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be: Continuing our mastery journey by completing the Mastering Number program to develop fluency and understanding.

- become familiar with and using numbers to 100.
- multiply numbers together in different ways.
- add/subtract a 2 digit number with a single digit number.

As HISTORIANS we will be: Learning about The Great Fire of London. This will include a visit and presentation from the Humberside fire service. We will also explore the importance of Samuel Pepys.

In DT we will be: Learning about the processes involved in bread making and trying our hand at baking some for ourselves.

In PSHE -In Jigsaw we will: Exploring the unit 'Celebrating Difference'. We will focus on what makes us special and unique.
